Your first and last name must be the same on all documentation- If your name is different on any of the documentation, please provide certified documentation for proof of name change such as a marriage certificate, divorce decree, or a court order. All applicants must contact a Nebraska State Patrol Troop Area and make an appointment to be fingerprinted and photographed as part of the application process.

This can be certification either as a State of Nebraska Certified Firearms Instructor (law enforcement only), a National Rifle Association Certified Pistol Instructor, or instructor in any other program meeting the legal Nebraska standards for instructor certification under Nebraska Revised Statute and Administrative Code.

Instructors **MUST** supply a valid phone number and e-mail for customer contact via the Nebraska State Patrol website. *This information must be current at all times; notify the Nebraska State Patrol immediately if changed.* If approved to be an instructor, certification is valid for a period of three (3) years from the date on approval letter (unless revoked sooner). **Submit your instructor curriculum with your name and contact information printed on it, along with your Instructor Application, to the Nebraska State Patrol for review and approval.
