

**Nebraska State Patrol Class 57**  
**Journal: Week #17**

Camp 57 started the week off with all nineteen recruits returning for a week of classroom and scenario work. Classwork consisted of Domestic Violence and HazMat Operations. We also had two tests; one over Confessions and the other over Criminal Investigations, Domestic Violence, and Evidence Procedures.

The week began with regularly scheduled PT in the morning. Classroom work began with the exam over Confessions and a full day of Domestic Violence. Tuesday and Wednesday saw Camp 57 completing Domestic Violence scenarios. The scenarios were completed in pairs with a range of complexity which shows the true light of what can happen while responding to a call for service. We quickly learned that you cannot take the same approach with every scenario as techniques which may work one way may not apply the next time.

HazMat Operations finished week #17 off for Camp 57. Friday the class took a field trip to Bosselman Tank and Trailer to get a closer look at different types of tankers and identifying types of hazardous material placards. This gave the class hands on experience of the types of trailers that they will see on the roadways and the materials being transported. The class was split into groups and given a hazardous material spill scenario, to determine the proper perimeter given the material, the number of extra officers needed, possible evacuation plans, and the course of actions taken place.

Camp 57 earned the battle streamer for week #17, meeting the standard that has been set. Camp 57 will strive to raise the standard in the weeks to come.
