Explosives Storage and/or Purchase Permit Applicant Instructions

1. Applicant Instructions – *Please read carefully before completing application*

- ☐ Application shall be electronically completed. **Handwritten applications will not be accepted.** Explanations and continuations on additional sheets of paper should be numbered to match the application item numbers that are being explained or continued.
- ☐ Issuance of your permit will be delayed if this application is incomplete or otherwise improperly prepared. Application should be submitted to the Nebraska State Patrol **at least 45 days in advance** of the date that the permit is required.
- ☐ Submission of this application **does not authorize** the applicant to engage in the requested activity. A permit must be obtained **before** operations commence.
- ☐ A separate application and permit fee is required for each property on which explosive materials are stored.
- ☐ If explosive materials are to be stored, the requirements of Title 272, Nebraska Administrative Code, Chapter 9 shall be complied with before the permit will be approved. All explosive storage facilities (magazines) to be used by the applicant, regardless of location, must be documented on attached sheets of paper.
- ☐ Each storage facility (magazine) must be fully described. Complete the attached Nebraska State Patrol Explosives Storage Magazine Worksheet for each magazine.
- ☐ **A minimum of one responsible person for storage locations must possess an Explosive User Permit issued by the Nebraska State Patrol. A permit from any other state entity (Fire Marshal's Office) will not be considered.**
- ☐ Responsible persons, as referred to in question 14 in the Business Information section of the Explosive Storage and/or Purchase Permit Application, means:
 - In the case of a corporation, partnership, limited liability company, or association; any individual possessing, directly or indirectly, the power to direct or cause the direction of the management, policies, and buying and selling practices of the corporation, partnership, or association, insofar as such management policies and buying/selling practices pertain to explosive materials; and
 - In the case of a corporation, association, or similar organization, any person owning ten percent (10%) or more of the outstanding shares of stock issued by the applicant business; and
 - In the case of a corporation, association, or similar organization, the officers and directors thereof; and
 - Permitted Nebraska State Patrol explosive user for applicant tasked with oversight of explosive storage and/or operations.
- ☐ Applicants wishing to make additions to or changes in construction or change locations of storage facilities shall complete an application and detail changes on the Nebraska State Patrol Explosives Storage Magazine Worksheet and/or diagrams.
- ☐ In the case of a manufacturer, a separate permit is not required with respect to the onsite manufacturing.
- ☐ The certification in section 4 of the Explosive Storage and/or Purchase Permit Application must be completed on the original application by the user, owner, a partner, or in the case of a corporation, association, etc., by an officer duly authorized to sign for the applicant.
