All applicants must contact a Nebraska State Patrol Troop Area and make an appointment to be fingerprinted and photographed as part of the application process.

This can be certification either as a State of Nebraska Certified Firearms Instructor (law enforcement only), a National Rifle Association Certified Pistol Instructor, or instructor in any other program meeting the legal Nebraska standards for instructor certification under Nebraska Revised Statute and Administrative Code.
