

FINGERPRINT IDENTIFICATION POLICY

Applicants must submit one current (unexpired) document from list A, OR 1 current (unexpired) document from both lists B and C. *PLEASE NOTE – The following list should not be considered all inclusive. Questions regarding acceptable identification that is not listed below should be forwarded to a Supervisor at the Criminal Identification Division at 402-479-4971.*

List A

Government issued Photo IDs

- State issued driver's license or identification card
- State issued identification card that contains date of birth or social security number
- U.S. Military Dependent's Identification card
- Alien Registration Card "Green Card" – Form I-551
- Employment Authorization Card – Form I-766 or I-688
- Re-entry Permit – Form I-327
- Certificate of U.S. Citizenship – Form N-560 or N-561
- Certificate of Naturalization – Form N-550 or N-570
- State issued concealed carry permit
- U.S. (or foreign) passport
- U.S. Military Identification card
- Native American Tribal Identification (with photo)
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner ID Card
- Free and Secure Trade (FAST) Card
- NEXUS Card
- Secure Electronic Network for Travelers Rapid Inspection (SENTRI) card
- Transportation Workers Identification Card (TWIC)

List B

Non-Government issued photo IDs

- School/student ID
- Work ID
- Organization or Association Membership ID
- Club membership ID
- Credit Card w/photo

List C

Government issued, non-photo IDs

- Social Security Card
- Certified copy of birth certificate issued by a State, county, municipal authority or territory of the United States bearing an official seal
- Native American Tribal document
- Certification of Birth Abroad issued by the U.S. Department of State (form FS-545 or FS-240)
- Certification of Report of Birth issued by the U.S. Department of State (form DS-1350)
- U.S. Citizen ID Card (form I-197)
- Identification card for Use of Resident Citizen in the U.S. (form I-179)
- Employment authorization document issued by the Department of Homeland Security
- U.S. civil marriage certificate
- U.S. Military discharge papers, contracts or orders
- A letter on Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services letterhead indicating the name and date of birth of a ward of the state.
